1999: Consolidation of the power generation activities of Alstom and ABB into ABB Alstom Power AG

2000: Sale of ABB's part to Alstom and formation of Alstom Power Austria

2010: Incorporation of the transport business and renaming to ALSTOM Austria GmbH

2014: Sale of the Alstom Energy businesses to General Electric

2015: Alstom finalizes the sales of its energy activities and is entirely focused on Transport
