History

1955: Delivery of 30 Electrical Multiple Units–E8000 –s ome of them are still in operation.

1970: Delivery of 418 DMU (Diesel-Electric Locomotives)

2000: Delivery of infrastructure and rolling stock to the first metro line (“M2”, Taksim-4.Levent) in Istanbul

2012: Istanbul office became the headquarters for the Middle East & Africa (MEA) region.

2014: Istanbul office became a regional centre for signalling and system projects.

Information

Alstom is a worldwide leader in rail equipment and services, offering the widest range of equipment on the market, from rolling stock and infrastructure to signalling, information systems and maintenance, as well as “turnkey” solutions.

Alstom started its activities in Turkey in the 1950s and has strongly contributed to transportation in Turkey through the delivery of metro cars, electromechanical works, electrical multiple units (EMU) and locomotives for the Turkish State Railways (TCDD).

Since 2012, Alstom’s offices in Turkey have been the headquarters for the Middle East & Africa (MEA) region. In 2014, the Istanbul office became a regional centre for signalling and system projects. Therefore, all bidding, project management, design, purchase, engineering, maintenance services for the signalling and system projects in the MEA region are conducted from Istanbul.

- TCDD (Turkish State Railways) / 18 Electrical Locomotives types E4000 and E40000 - 1955 and 1969 → First Electrical Locomotives in Turkey
- TCDD (Turkish State Railways) / 418 DMU (Diesel-Electric Locomotives) type CoCo - 1970 → 226 still in operation
