

Alstom is present in Kazakhstan since 2010 with more than **800 employees** and after **10 years** of continuous development, it now has **7 sites** throughout the country: two Joint Ventures: EKZ in Nur-Sultan for electric locomotives production and maintenance and KazElectroPrivod (KEP) in Almaty for the production of point machines; three service depots, one repairing center and one administrative office. Alstom is the only manufacturer of electric locomotives and point machines in the Central Asian and Caucasian region and a major contributor to the revitalisation of its rail industry and the development of its economy.
