

Alstom announces appointment of new President of Digital & Integrated Systems

10 January **2024** – Alstom, global leader in smart and sustainable mobility, announces today the appointment of Aymeric Sarrazin President Digital & Integrated Systems, effective 1st February 2024, replacing Jean-François Beaudoin, who has decided to pursue his career outside of Alstom. He also acquired extensive experience in digital technologies, their business applications and their transformational potential.
