Alstom offers apprenticeships from Level 2-6.

Alstom require a minimum of five GCSE's Grade 5-9 to include Mathematics, English and Science.

An apprenticeship will last three years on average, depending on the level. An apprenticeship standard will be a blend of nationally recognised qualifications along with 'on' and 'off the job' training. Apprentices will attend college either on day release or block delivery.

Alstom recruits apprentices for a range of business functions including Engineering, Manufacturing, Train Maintenance, Project Management and Supply Chain. The overall goal of our Graduate Scheme is to provide suitably educated and trained employees to meet the company's future business needs.

Over the duration of the scheme, the graduate trainees will participate in a robust and structured programme of activities, including work placements and a comprehensive development programme.




