Alstom Canada is expressing its commitment to the Partnership Accreditation in Indigenous Relations (PAIR) program from the Canadian Council for Indigenous Business. This participation reinforces Alstom Canada's [Commitment to Indigenous Peoples](#), supporting clear accountability and measurable progress in collaboration with Indigenous Peoples and communities on the territories where the company operates.

Through our participation in the PAIR Program, we aim to strengthen our organizational practices and demonstrate leadership in Indigenous relations. The PAIR Program provides a high level of assurance through the independent, third party verification of company reports on measurable outcomes and initiatives in four performance areas: Leadership Actions, Employment, Business Development, and Community Relations (Engagement and Support).

Established in 2001, the PAIR program includes an online management and reporting tool that supports participating companies' efforts towards progressive improvement in Indigenous relations, and a certification program that confirms corporate performance in Indigenous relations at the bronze, silver or gold level.

Through the PAIR framework, Alstom Canada aims to further strengthen its contributions to reconciliation and foster long-term, trust-based relationships with Indigenous Peoples.
